Specific Projects

Provided 6,000 diaper suits for children ages zero to three.

Supplied three years worth of long-term food storage for 300 + children.



Provided immediate food needs (six-month supplies) for 500 + children on multiple occasions.

Supplied 500 + children with new clothing.

Provided 500 + children with daily vitamins, regular vaccinations, and basic and advanced medical care.

Completely remodeled and renovated an entire orphanage for 80 + children, including new kitchen equipment, windows, floors, walls, plumbing, tiling, bathroom fixtures, lighting, cribs, beds, toys, playground equipment, washing machines, etc.

Renovated a gymnasium for 60 + children, including new playground equipment.

Remodeled a 2,000 square foot kitchen with new tiles, ventilation, lighting, walls, etc.

Provided two-year supplies of sanitation products (including diapers and detergents) for over 300 + children.

Renovated a music and activities room, including new flooring, ceilings, walls, drapes, windows, doors, etc.

Renovated a medical room for basic procedures and dental work, including purchasing all new equipment.

Other

Volunteered over 10,000 service hours in Ukraine.

Led group of 15 student volunteers on three-week humanitarian mission.

Successfully aided in several international adoptions.
